HOW IT WORKS

How does it work?
What's going to happen?

You'll start in our Shire Hall, where our costumed characters will be mingling with guests over a cocktail or mocktail, so collect your drink and join them. Now is a good time to get to know who the characters are and what they're like, but don't worry if you don't get a chance. You'll meet them properly soon.

Hopefully by now you have a theory about Who, How and Why, so write it on the sleuth pack (along with your team name) and hand it to one of the characters. We'll get everyone together one last time and reveal the solution and name the team or teams who got it right.

Everyone will get together to find out the details of the crime and collect their sleuth packs. These have space for team name, notes on each character, and your solution at the end of the night. There's also a clipboard and pen for your convenience.

Once you've seen everyone it's back upstairs to think it over with drinks. You might have extra questions, especially for the characters you saw early on, and you can ask these when the characters rejoin you.

You'll be guided round the museum to meet each character in turn. This is your chance to ask what they know about the crime, ask for alibis, and see what dirt they can spill on the other characters. Make notes about anything interesting as you go!

Hint: Some characters might have things to show as well as tell!
